

### **Discrimination is Taxpayer Funded in Ohio via Vouchers**

Taxpayers in Ohio help fund private schools via vouchers and direct state payments to private schools. Private schools can and do discriminate in regard to enrollment practices, due process for students and employees, and a plethora of other ways.
