Business as usual in the charter industry: Finding for recovery in the amount of \$543,478 issued against a former charter school superintendent.

The charter school industry in Ohio has a dismal record of fraud and corruption. ECOT has served as the north star of fraud and corruption in the Ohio charter industry; but rip-off of taxpayers, with students being the victims, is common place in charterville. The primary reason for charter industry corruption is that charters are privately-operated in a largely unaccountable and non-transparent environment. The lack of regulations invites charter operators to pad their pockets with tax money, while operating classrooms on the cheap.

The Ohio universal voucher scheme will become fertile for all kinds of misuses of tax revenue. There is no accountability or transparency for state revenue spent on vouchers.
