77% of the EdChoice expansion voucher students are from 285 Ohio school districts.

EdChoice expansion voucher students are spread very unevenly among the 612 Ohio school districts.

Andrew Wilson, former Fairborn school district Board of Education member, has been mining some Ohio Department of Education and Workforce Development voucher data to determine the distribution of voucher students among school districts in Ohio and how the universal EdChoice voucher scheme impacts various school districts in terms of voucher student enrollment.

285 school districts have 50 or more EdChoice voucher students. These 285 school districts account for 77% of the voucher students during this school year. Approximately 200 districts have between 10 and 49 voucher students and in the range of 100 districts have less than 10 voucher students.

3 districts had no EdChoice voucher expansion students until this current school year: Bellefontaine now has 109; Kirtland now has 62, and Ironton now has 83.
