

June 1 News [report](#) on News4 Tucson: Fight over school vouchers in Arizona could go another round.

Some state officials in Ohio seem to be competing with Arizona in the voucher race to destroy public education. A community organizer in Arizona is fighting back. In Ohio, the Ohio Coalition for Equity and Adequacy of School Funding/Vouchers Hurt Ohio (VHO) is fighting back via the EdChoice voucher lawsuit. Nealy one-third of Ohio school districts are participating in the Ohio confrontation with the voucher schemers.

In 2018 Arizona voters rejected a statewide voucher proposal by a 65% majority. Arizona politicians ignored the will of the people and established a voucher scheme. Ohio politicians ram voucher schemes into budget bills in the dead of the night while Ohioans are resting so as to be able to work the next day and pay taxes. Ohio politicians then are illegally giving tax money to private schools via vouchers. As the Senate president said, "We kind of do what we want..."

Ohio politicians seem to want to outdo Arizona by proposing capital funds for private schools to increase the demand for vouchers. They are not satisfied with universal vouchers; they want to create a higher demand for vouchers.
