A view of what vouchers for various public services would look like:

- Police vouchers depleting police department funds for private security purposes.

- Parks and recreation vouchers depleting the agency budget for Country Club dues.
- Education vouchers depleting the school districts' budgets for the operation of private schools.
- Library vouchers depleting the library funds to purchase a private collection of books.
- Transportation vouchers depleting the public transportation agency budget for purchase and operation of private vehicles.

Vouchers work against the public good, the social contract, and community peaceful co-existence.
