

Update on certain EdChoice voucher data.

Coalition Steering Committee member Andrew Wilson provides the following update:

1. Not low-income qualified voucher users is greater in FY2025 than in FY2024.
 - a. FY2025 not low-income qualified: 88,708
 - b. FY2024 not low-income qualified and low-income qualified: 88,103; hence not low-income qualified in FY2025 is greater than both groups in FY2024.
2. 88.7% of EdChoice vouchers statewide are going to families with incomes greater than \$140,400. (Consider that the statewide median income is \$43,371).
3. EdChoice expansion now is up to 100,023.
