

A Call to Action Kit to advocate for the Fair School Funding Plan regarding the 2026 and 2027 fiscal years budget.

The House School Funding proposal underfunds Ohio school districts by \$2.75 billion. Yes, \$2.75 billion!

All in for Ohio Kids coalition partners (including OEA, OFT, OAPSE, Policy Matters Ohio, Ohio Organizing Collaborative) has developed a [Call to Action Kit](#) which provides key information about the Fair School Funding Plan and HOW MUCH EACH DISTRICT WOULD RECEIVE UNDER THE FSFP COMPARED TO WHAT THE DISTRICT WOULD RECEIVE UNDER THE HOUSE VERSION FOR THE NEXT TWO YEARS.

FOR EXAMPLE: Mason City school district would receive \$1,802,485 MORE BUT UNDER THE HOUSE PLAN, only \$482,240.

The House Budget reduces funding to school districts, while increasing voucher and charter school funding.
