## EdChoice and EdChoice expansion voucher numbers in Ohio

It is well known that state officials in Ohio have never fully funded the education needs of public school district students but have been quite generous to the unconstitutional EdChoice voucher program. Two spreadsheets are attached. One lists the <a href="EdChoice voucher expansion">EdChoice voucher expansion</a> head count and amount of money received by each private school. The other spreadsheet provides the same data for the <a href="EdChoice voucher program">EdChoice voucher program</a>.

The total number of EdChoice expansion vouchers is 101,107 at a taxpayer cost of \$492,623,252.34. The total number of EdChoice vouchers for fiscal year 2025 is 42,725 at a taxpayer cost of \$283,073,580.97. More than 175 districts received more than \$1 million in taxfunded EdChoice expansion vouchers. (80 private schools received more than \$1 million for EdChoice vouchers.)

The Cupp/Patterson Fair School Funding plan could have been fully funded but for the EdChoice voucher scheme.
