

Federal HR7086: “To support the creation and implementation of State policies, as well as the expansion of existing State policies, for improving the quality and affordability of charter school facilities and to authorize the provision of technical assistance to support the growth and expansion of high-quality charter schools.”

This federal bill would provide assistance to charter schools for facilities. The assistance would be in the form of grants to states. The motive behind this proposed legislation is to expand the failed charter school industry.

The federal government and the state government of Ohio continue to enact legislation that gives greater priority to charters and vouchers than to the constitutionally required public common school system. State and federal officials seem to pay no attention to the lack of desirable outcomes, accountability and transparency in these privately operated industries.
