

**Utah Judge rules vouchers unconstitutional.**

The Utah voucher law was ruled unconstitutional. How could the ruling be otherwise in Utah? Or in any other state?

State constitutions throughout the 50 states provide for a system of public education. None of the state constitutions authorized public funding for those who choose private education or the private schools they choose.
