

What to look for in the State Defendant's presentation to the 10th District Court of Appeals on May 12.

Each side in the EdChoice voucher litigation will have 30 minutes to present to the 10th District Court of Appeals, 373 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio. During the trial court hearings, the State Defendants came up short in convincing the court that the Ohio Constitution permits the state to fund the private school system with tax-funded EdChoice vouchers.

The State Defendants, represented by the Attorney General's Office and state-funded private counsel, as well as two intervenors, struggled to find even a thread of evidence that the Ohio Constitution authorizes the EdChoice vouchers scheme.
