

May 12th Ohio EdChoice voucher case—What to know.

The Franklin County trial court ruled the EdChoice voucher scheme unconstitutional on three counts on June 24th, 2025. The State Defendants appealed the case to the 10th District Court of Appeals. The Coalition/VHO Plaintiffs cross appealed on one count.

The Ohio Constitution is very clear on the state's responsibility to secure a thorough and efficient system of common schools and the prohibition to fund religious private schools. The Coalition Plaintiff school districts will present a powerful case against the EdChoice voucher scheme on May 12th. The State Defendants cannot construe the Ohio Constitution to give license to the state to use tax funds to fund private education with EdChoice vouchers.
