

Report from the Ohio State Fair: Most fairgoers who stop at the Coalition/VHO booth are very disturbed that Ohio taxpayers are subsidizing private school tuition.

Legislators and other state officials who support the tax-funded EdChoice vouchers are out-of-touch with a majority of the taxpaying public with regard to the state's EdChoice voucher scheme.

Contrasted with fairgoers three years ago, a significant majority of fairgoers are aware of the state's EdChoice voucher scheme; and they, for the most part, are angry that the out-of-touch state officials are subsidizing private school tuition with these tax funds. Ohio has unconstitutionally established a private school system—a distinct, separate system from the constitutionally-required system. Many private school budgets are comprised of more than 75% in tax funds—with no accountability to the public.

The November election will begin to reflect the citizens' angry sentiment toward the EdChoice voucher scheme.
