

An August 24, 2023, presentation by the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland shows, at that time, that the EdChoice voucher program covered in the range of 80% of the private school's revenue.

A private school that the taxpayers [subsidize at the rate of 80%](#) should undergo state audits and expenditure reports should be made available to the public. In fact, all private schools that receive public money (vouchers, nonpublic administrative cost reimbursement, auxiliary services and student transportation) should be audited by the Auditor of State and demonstrate accountability and transparency to the taxpaying public. .

The private school system should be required to pay into the state retirement systems and follow the same regulations as public schools.
